- Middle Circle: Present
- Outside Circle: Tomorrow

Inner Circle Representation

Wagon: A historic symbol that represents Hiram Young, his noble cause and aspirations that makes this center shall live on through the spirit of Lion’s Volunteerism.

Middle Circle Representation

People and Community is what this circle represents. It stands for the people that come together for a common cause of making a difference to the lives of fellow humans within the community the Lions evolve with and beyond.

Outside Circle Representation

Hiram Young Community Service Center: is a holistic representation of the facility as a community institution that is dedicated to providing blends of inspiration, skills and expertise in community volunteerism.

Motto: “Blazing the trail of Service”

This is the institutional slogan of Hiram Young Community Center and embodies its institutional mission, vision, goals and objectives.

Color Harmony and Representation:

Radiant Hue for the outside circle- it is a rainbow of colors that signifies a light of hope.
 Pastel Color of the middle circle – it is a radiant color for the great plains of Midwest.
 Blue Color for the inner Circle – it represents the true blue color of “Lionism”.

Summary:

The Logo - is a wall, thread, spoke and hub of a Wagon Wheel!

The logo is a wagon wheel that would blaze the trail of service to humanity. The Hiram Young Community Service Center would serve as the wall and thread of the wheel; the people and community as the spoke that would supports the wall and thread to carry on the services; and the wagon as the hub, that would represents the legacy of late Hiram Young and what the center would stand for as a facility of true service delivery by unselfish volunteerism.

The inner circle color changed to the Lions color of “purple” and the middle circle changed to a lighter shade of “purple” radiating the “purple plains” theme.
